Key activities and Implementation modalities

Developing model beekeepers through capacity enhancement and periodic monitoring and follow up visits, and equipping them with modern beekeeping techniques for improving livelihoods and influencing others for adopting modern beekeeping had been the implementation modality

The major activities of the project included baseline survey, production, processing and marketing level trainings, beehive making training, orientation workshop on honey utility, input support, exposure visit and end-line survey.

Major Achievements

- 28 household members received knowledge and skill of production, processing, marketing, and beehive
 making through training, orientation workshop and visiting successful areas and enterprises of beekeeping
 in Nepal.
- Two honey processing units supported with 50% cost contribution for common use by beneficiaries
- Publication of Beekeeping manual (500 copies) in Nepali Version

Impact

The household beneficiaries improved their income through modern beekeeping and about 25% of the beneficiaries replicated their learning to neighbors, and motivated others to adopt modern beekeeping
